- Significance of Indian Knowledge System and the applications of decolonial frameworks as components of methodological and epistemic justice in social research

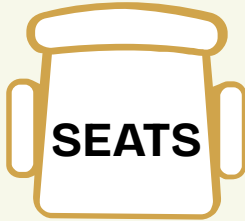
OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

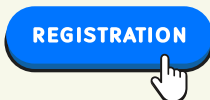

ABOUT US

THE UNIVERSITY

The Indira Gandhi National Tribal University, Amarkantak, has been established by an Act of the Parliament of India. It came into existence through the Indira Gandhi National Tribal University Act, 2007. The University's jurisdiction extends nationwide, and it is fully funded by the Central Government through the University Grants Commission. The University caters to the tribal communities' long-cherished dream of higher education.

THE DEPARTMENT

The Department of Physical Education, under the Faculty of Education, was established in 2022 to provide quality undergraduate, postgraduate, and research programs in physical education and sports science, with special focus on tribal and underrepresented communities. The department launched its UG program in 2023–24 under NEP 2020, followed by a PG program in 2024–25 and a PhD program in 2025. The curriculum offers a holistic understanding of sports science, fitness, and physical education while promoting teamwork, discipline, leadership, and sportsmanship.

AMARKANTAK

Amarkantak is one of the best tourist and religious places of Madhya Pradesh, situated at an average elevation of 1048 metres (3438 ft). Here, the Vindhya, Satpura, and Maikal mountain ranges meet. It is also the holy origin point of the Narmada, Son, and Johila rivers.
