Webinar on “Gynaecological Challenges in Girls” to Promote Health Awareness and Prevention

On 06 October 2025, the NSS Unit of Indira Gandhi National Tribal University (IGNTU), Amarkantak successfully organized a vital health awareness webinar titled “Gynecological Challenges in Girls: Awareness, Management, and Prevention. The session aimed at empowering young women, particularly students, with essential knowledge about reproductive and gynecological health.

The program was graced by Hon’ble Prof. Byomakesh Tripathy, Vice-Chancellor, IGNTU, who addressed the participants with an inspiring message. He commended the NSS team for organizing a program focused on such a sensitive and essential topic and emphasized the need for awareness, particularly for vulnerable and marginalized groups such as adolescent girls. Prof. Tripathy extended his blessings and best wishes to the organizers and participants, stressing that such initiatives help in building a more informed, healthy, and empowered youth.

The keynote speaker for the webinar was Dr. Kavita Khoiwal, MD, F.MAS, Additional Professor, Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology, AIIMS Rishikesh. A leading expert in her field, Dr. Khoiwal was featured in the Limca Book of Records 2023 for performing a record-breaking removal of the heaviest malignant ovarian tumor weighing 41.1 kg.

In her detailed and interactive session, Dr. Khoiwal addressed a wide range of important topics, including:

- 1) Female Reproductive Health and Development
- 2) Common Gynecological Problems in Young Girls and Women
- 3) Menstrual Health and Related Disorders
- 4) Vaginal Infections: Bacterial, Fungal, and Parasitic
- 5) Urinary Tract Infections (UTIs)
- 6) Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs)
- 7) Pelvic Inflammatory Disease (PID)
- 8) HPV and Cervical Health
- 9) Importance of Hygiene and Safe Practices
- 10) Mental and Emotional Impact of Gynecological Issues
- 11) When to Seek Medical Help: Recognizing Red Flags
- 12) Prevention Strategies, Vaccination, and Healthy Habits
- 13) Myths vs. Facts in Women’s Health
- 14) Breaking the Stigma Through Awareness

Dr. Khoiwal emphasized the need for open communication, early intervention, and health education to

protect and promote gynecological health among young girls. She encouraged students to make informed choices and not hesitate to consult healthcare professionals when needed.

The event was coordinated under the leadership of Dr. Jayanta Kumar Behera, NSS Programme Coordinator, and Dr. Devnarayan, NSS Programme Officer, with active support from the NSS team comprising Dr. Janki Prasad, Dr. Kunjbihari Sulakhiya, Dr. Anand Sughdhe, Dr. Suhel Ahamad Khan, Dr. Amrita Singh, and Mr. Rajesh Kumar Turkel.

The webinar saw the enthusiastic participation of around 80 students, including numerous NSS volunteers, who engaged actively in the discussion. The session provided them with valuable knowledge, cleared many misconceptions, and fostered a deeper understanding of personal health and hygiene.
